This will continue to grow our meetings, sports, and other tourism verticals, which deliver solid job opportunities and pay to residents," says Cordo.

Board Chair Kelly Harrill expressed his enthusiasm. "We are all very excited about Tony joining the Greensboro CVB family. His years of experience in a major market, his forward-looking nature, and polished skill set will serve our hospitality community well for years to come."

Cordo is known for building strong community partnerships and was recently named the Community Partner of the Year by the Hollywood (FL) Chamber of Commerce. "I pride myself in looking for mutually beneficial, pragmatic ways to build up partners," Cordo explained. "The rising tide can lift all ships."

Cordo also shared excitement for Greensboro's arts and entertainment scene. "There are a lot of great attractions in Greensboro, and the growing live-music scene in Greensboro particularly excites me," he said. "I intend to collaborate with stakeholders to establish the vision for Greensboro as a destination. My vision is to see the day that Greensboro is known internationally as America's vibrant, authentic, genuine destination."
